

All the world seen and unseen is mind and it is universal or everywhere present in its nature. This one universal mind which is in us has dual aspects of consciousness. One aspect is called objective or conscious and the other subjective or unconscious mind. The objective aspect is what we use with our day to day interaction with our five senses and wakeful awareness. The other is the aspect of consciousness that we don't actively think about that beats our heart, operates our cells and allows us to grow from infants into adults. It is also responsible for the communicated intelligence of Spirit in animals as their natural instincts and to man as his intuition, inspiration and human race history.

This subjective side of mind is universal. This universality exists prior to birth. Everything necessary to bring things into existence be it in the human form or in plants and animals. All creation exists in wholeness and perfect intelligence, prior to its objective appearance on the planet.

Take for example a seed. When it is planted in soil, something happens. Innate within the seed is the perfect and complete intelligence to produce a plant, be it an oak tree or tomato. Once in the soil, a law of mind, acting on the subjective side of all life, takes over and with the soil, is operated upon to produce the plant. In human expression we have conscious awareness for example, of how to drive a car, yet we take no thought of how we calculate distance, speed or reaction for that is all exquisitely accomplished by intelligence developed within our human form by subjective mind within our being. Our individual nature, partakes of inherent subjective abilities allowing us to not concern our selves with physics and just enjoy driving the car.

Every thought we think emanates from us like a radio wave. Some people are more susceptible to these waves of thought than others. For example, why do we feel comfortable with some people in a room and strangely distant to others? It's because we carry what is called a mental atmosphere around with us, comprised of the total thoughts, actions and feelings that we have ever felt or thought, however we are not totally conscious of it, and most are deeply suppressed. Yet some people can "read" and or objectify these thought vibrations, however with varying degrees of success.

Ernest Holmes explains in *The Science of Mind*: "Universal mind is present as thought everywhere, and what is known in one place, may be known in all places. Time, space and obstructions are unknown to mind and thought. It follows that anyone tuning into our thought, will enter into our stream of consciousness, no matter where we are and no matter where he may be. Past and present are one and the same in Mind".

As I pointed out in the example of the seed, the past, through the present and into the future, is causation passing from cause to effect. We plant the seed and let nature or universal intelligence do its work and soon we have a harvest. All this process is known within the subjectivity of the seed and it's interaction with the soil. This intelligence is known now, in all past and known in all future. It is the complete idea contained in universal subjective mind prior to individualizing into materiality in our objective world.

Within each of us is embedded the universality of perfect mind, perfect being, perfect man. How wonderful to know, within you and within me is something so beautiful and perfect, so full of potential from the beginning of all life, awaiting our individual expression of it as us, each unique, yet each united in the one great subjective mind.
